

RESOLUTION NUMBER 3870 (11-03-21) AMENDED

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND PERMIT RATES & REQUIREMENTS FOR MOBILE VENDING

WHEREAS, Mobile Vending is considered any temporary activity and/or apparatus which the operator prepares, assembles, or displays with the intent to sell such items to the public (excluding produce stands). and

WHEREAS, a need has arisen for a permitting process for Mobile Vendors and Transient Vendors in the city; and

WHEREAS, the following are the proposed requirements and rates for permits a vendor can select:

<u>Period</u>	<u>Fee</u>
Monthly Permit	\$25.00
Quarterly Permit	\$50.00
Yearly Permit	\$100.00

Food Trucks must be moved every day.

To apply for a Mobile Vendor permit, you must have: Copy of State of Tennessee Sales & Use Tax Certificate, Copy of State of Tennessee Health Department Permit, and vehicle information (make, model, description, and tag number), and inspected by the City Fire Chief.

Events sponsored or sanctioned by the City of Hohenwald are exempt from permitting. These events include but are not limited to: Christmas in Hohenwald, Oktoberfest, etc. Fund raisers organized by nonprofits are exempt.

Application must be on file at City Hall and Permit must be on display at Mobile Vending site.

Permits shall expire Thirty (30) Days, Ninety (90) Days, or One (1) year, respectively, after issued.

****A Transient Vendor Permit is required if the Mobile Vendor is from outside of Lewis County****

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF HOHENWALD, that these rates and procedures take effect January 1, 2021.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption, the welfare of the City requiring it.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 3925 (11-04-21)

A RESOLUTION TO SET PERMIT RATES & REQUIREMENTS FOR TRANSIENT VENDORS

WHEREAS, Transient Vendors are any vendors from outside of Lewis County that setup booths, trailers, tents or other temporary vending operations where products of any kind are to be sold; and

WHEREAS, a need has arisen for a permitting process for Transient Vendors in the city; and

WHEREAS, the following are the proposed requirements and rates for permits:

Transient Vending Permit. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, corporation, partnership, association or any other organization from outside of Lewis County to setup any booth, trailer, tent or other temporary vending operations where products of any kind are to be sold within the corporate limits of the City of Hohenwald, without obtaining a Transient Vending Permit in compliance with this resolution.

Application for permit. Applicants for a temporary vending permit must file with the city recorder a written application containing the following:

- 1) The name and addresses of the persons, firm, corporations, or other organizations wishing to obtain permit;
- 2) The permanent address of the owner
- 3) The address of the business or firm
- 4) The dates of operation.

Cost of Permit. The cost of the permit is \$50 for 14 consecutive days. The cost of renewal is \$50.

****This does not apply to organized events or fundraisers organized by a nonprofit****

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF HOHENWALD, that these rates and procedures take effect January 1, 2021.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption, the welfare of the City requiring it.
